Fundraising ideas for your school

By implementing a combination of the below fundraising ideas, schools can engage with their community, raise awareness about the benefits of sensory rooms and secure the necessary funding they need to create the ideal inclusive Learning environment for all students.

- Quiz or Bingo nights- Host a quiz or bingo night for students, parents, and community members. Charge an entry and offer prizes to the winning teams/individuals, you can also incorporate additional fundraising activities such as raffles. Approach local companies to provide prizes
- Non-Uniform day - Charge a nominal fee to allow all pupils to come dressed in their own clothes
- Disco Night- Let the students party the night away in return for a ticket price donation and raise money from the sale of tuck box items
- Bake Sale- Organise a cake sale where students and parents bake and donate cakes, cookies, and other sweet treats to sell at the school or a local event.
- Movie night- Host a movie night at the school after hours, children can watch the movie in return for a donation/ticket price, charge additional donation for popcorn and snacks

Reach out to parents and the community do you have any keen runners? Members of the local community maybe willing to aid your fundraising efforts by taking part in various sponsored walks or runs.
